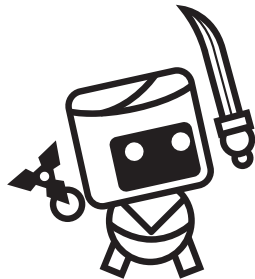

WHAT NINJA ARE YOU?

Ninja Division represents many different games and products. A member of the Ninja Corps will also represent a variety of games and products. Each member does not need to have a demo set for each game, but we look to our members to be able to represent our full line either at the hobby store, conventions, or online.

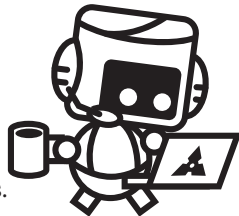
Game Ninja

A player may submit an application to represent any (or all) of the games published by Ninja Division Publishing. A Game Ninja is expected to own a copy and have a strong familiarity with any games they represent.



Web Ninja

Along with hobby store and convention support, a volunteer can become a Web Ninja. Web Ninja's provide online support through blogs, podcasts, vidcasts, and forums.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

We are looking for people that are excited to help promote Ninja Division on all fronts, whether it is in the hobby store or online. If this calls out to you, please see the Application Requirements below.

Players interested in joining the Ninja Corps must submit the following:

- A completed application and picture of yourself.
- Pictures of game playable components for at least two players from the chosen game(s) you will be representing.
 - ▷ These must be the components that will be used for demo or review purposes.
 - ▷ Models for Relic Knights and Alien v Predator (AVP) must be painted and based.
- A passion for gaming, hobbying and a strong conviction to build a community around the games promoted.
- Be at least 18 years old.
- Knowledge of the chosen game(s) rules, including errata, and story background.

RESPONSIBILITIES

As part of the Ninja Corps, members will be expected to lead and create events, along with review and build online content for the community. There are many different events that members of the Ninja Corps can run:

- Demos
- Tournaments
- Hobby/Paint Event
- Release Event
- Leagues
- Playtester

Online Content can involve:

- Blogs
- Reviews
- Podcasts
- Vidcasts

EXPECTATIONS

Along with creating events and content, a Ninja Corps member is representing Ninja Division and members will be seen as a reflection of the company. Because of this, we require members to have a certain level of professionalism in which they act in all ventures that would reflect on themselves and Ninja Division.

Basics such as making sure you and your clothes are clean, not using foul language, and respecting other gamers, are essential to being a Ninja Corps member who encourages people to participate in the Ninja Division hobby.

It is also important to respect the venue you are running your event in. Make sure to abide by all the rules set by the venue, and that your players both know and follow them. Clean up at the end of the event. It doesn't matter how good the event was if the venue won't let you run another one!

REPORTING EVENTS

After an event is over or online content has been posted, it is then the duty of the Ninja Corps member to report back to the Ninja Master.

The member should include the following in the report:

- Name
- Forum Username
- Event Name
- Event Type
- Game
- Number of Players
- Venue
- Date
- Country
- State
- City
- Street
- Store/Convention Contact
- Email
- Phone
- Pictures or URL of the Event or Content
- Description/Summary

CONVENTIONS:

Ninja Corps members and volunteers can work at conventions where Ninja Division has a booth and runs events. Along with the expectations that are listed above, Ninja Division holds our members and volunteers as part of the group and brand that we present. Volunteers must agree to and sign a code of conduct form to work at an official Ninja Division event.

Convention schedules and volunteer sign-ups are posted in the Ninja Corps forums. Volunteers may sign-up for specific events and shifts at the booth. Shifts are assigned as 4-hour slots. Ninja Division provides all materials that

volunteers will require for their shift during the event. Contact the Ninja Master for additional questions about convention support.

COMPENSATION

When a report has been submitted the member is now eligible for points/credit in the Ninja Division Online Store. These points can be spent on product. A breakdown of events for points can be seen below:

- Demo
 - ▷ Every complete 4 hours
 - ▷ **4000 Ninja Stars**
- Tournament (Single Day)
 - ▷ 6 - 12 participants
 - ▷ **4000 Ninja Stars**
- Tournament (Single Day)
 - ▷ 13+ participants
 - ▷ **5000 Ninja Stars**
- League
 - ▷ 6 week, 6+ participants minimum
 - ▷ **5000 Ninja Stars**
- Special Event (cons, multi-day tournament, etc)
 - ▷ Ninja Division Sanctioned
 - ▷ **Varies by event**
- Online Content varies by content
- Playtesting varies by participation
